Summer Sizzlers Day Camps

Summer Sizzlers is our general camp program designed to offer a full-day, week-long outdoor and indoor play program with HIGH FIVE trained staff. Programs are age appropriate and full of activities that emphasize fun, participation and friendship based on a weekly theme. Each week offers entertaining special guests, crafts and sports, or an off-site trip. Selected sites have swim sessions three times per week. No special skills are required. No special equipment needed.

Who can Register?

Tots: Age 4 and 5 (must be 4 by the program start date)

Tykes: Age 6 and 7 (must be 6 by Dec. 31, 2017) **Juniors:** Age 8 and 9 (must be 8 by Dec. 31, 2017) **Seniors:** Age 10 to 12 (must be 10 by Dec. 31, 2017)

Leadership Staff

All staff are selected based on their experience and enthusiasm. All staff must have:

- Standard First Aid and CPR
- HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development
- Criminal record check
- Attended mandatory pre-camp training

Off-site trip/On-site special guest: Each week will feature an off-site trip or on-site guest for each age group. Where possible, trips/guests will be scheduled Tuesday through Thursday of the camp week. Transportation and admissions are included in the weekly camp fee. Trips may include walking or chartered buses. A final list of on-site guests and off-site trips will be available online in June on our Camp Week-at-a-Glance page on oakville.ca.

Swimming: Campers swim three times per week. "Swim to Survive" is a structured instructional program offered for the Tykes. Juniors and Seniors participate in a recreational swim time. Swim assessments will be done by the Aquatic staff.

Please note: Tots do not swim.

Camp-Wide Day: Theme-related challenges between all ages. **Supervision Ratios**

Tots: 1:8 ratio Tykes, Juniors, Seniors: 1:12 ratio

Program Hours

Camp hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily. Campers are welcome on site five minutes before start time and should be picked up promptly at 4:30 p.m. Before and after-care hours are available on site at selected locations, for an additional registration fee.

Campers with Special Needs

The Town of Oakville welcomes residents with disabilities to become involved in our summer camp programs. If any of the following apply, our special needs programs may be an appropriate program choice for your child:

- Extra support is required at school.
- Extra support is required at home for basic care such as dressing and toileting.
- A disability exists that may affect the safety of your child or that of others in the program.
- Your child is associated with a support agency.

Please consider if your child will be able to handle recreation activities with the following components:

- Full-day, week-long programs that operate Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Changes in programming/routine that may occur due to uncontrollable factors.
- Program locations that are shared with other groups, such as other programs or the general public.
- Inclusion support workers who may be high school/ college/university students who are hired based on their interest and skill level related to working with participants with disabilities.

Age Policy

To register for programs for persons with disabilities, participants must be within the age range of the program by December 31 of the year the program is taken.

Exception: Four-year-olds entering our programs must be the required age by the start of the program.

Who to Contact

For more information on our one-on-one support, please contact the Program Supervisor – Child, Youth and Camps at 905-845-6601, ext. 3624.

If you are new to the Town of Oakville's inclusion programs, please contact us to determine the level of the support that may be required to participate. Levels of support may include: volunteers, inclusion support workers (at varying ratios) and/or family-provided support worker.



Registration

Registration fees listed on the next page include leadership support, plus the camp program fee. If you require before and after-care, please register separately for that service at the location you will be attending. One-on-one staff will provide support during the camp program but not extended hours. There will be staff with expertise in special needs on site but may not be your designated support person. Once you have registered, a staff person will contact you prior to summer to set up an intake meeting. This meeting will allow us to understand what support your child requires to be successful in the program.

Medically Fragile Participants

Participants who are medically fragile and who require the use of medical equipment are welcome to attend programs. Program staff are not trained in this area, therefore the family must provide a support worker to be responsible for the participant's medical requirements.

Support Persons

Families are welcome to provide their own support worker. Families may need to provide their own workers if the one-to-one support program is full or if the participant's needs exceed our level of support available (i.e. medical). The support worker may be required to attend a training session and provide a criminal record check. Support persons will be required to complete a waiver and a personal information form in the event of an emergency. There are no admission or registration fees for support workers.

What you need to know

Camp Hours

Camp hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily. Campers are welcome to arrive five minutes before start time and should be picked up promptly at 4:30 p.m. Before and after-care hours are available at selected locations for an additional registration fee.

Safe arrival and dismissal

The Town of Oakville is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for your child(ren). Our safe arrival and dismissal process ensures that campers are only released into the care of their parent/guardian, or into the care of an individual designated by the parent/guardian. EVERYONE who picks up a child from camp is REQUIRED to show photo identification. Authorization forms will be available at the time of registration. Leadership staff will be wearing their staff shirts and photo identification badge, and signs will identify specific program areas.

Leader Qualifications

All staff are selected based on their experience and enthusiasm. All staff must have:

- Standard First Aid and CPR
- HIGH FIVE Principles of Healthy Child Development
- Police screening check

In addition to providing these qualifications, all staff are required to attending pre-camp training sessions focusing on children's safety and programming.

Supervision Ratios

- Children 4 to 5 years of age: 1 to 8 ratio
- Children 5 years of age and older: 1 to 12 ratio Ratios are enhanced with support from trained youth volunteers and LIT participants.

Program Schedules

Prior to the first day of camp, schedules and off-site information will be emailed to participants. Please ensure that your email is provided at the time of registration and that your account information is current.

Off-site Trip Supervision

All participants and staff members attend the off-site trip together. Staff ratios are maintained at all times. Busing to and from the trip location is provided by approved school bus charters.

Busing

Staff will be at the designated pick-up location by 7:30 a.m. and travel with campers to and from QEPCCC. Staff will remain at pick-up locations until 6 p.m. Campers will follow the same safe dismissal process. Photo ID must be shown at pick-up.

Photo Release

Photographs of participants may be taken at any time for Town of Oakville promotional purposes. If you do not wish to have your/your child's photo/name used, please contact us at 905-338-4250.

Inclement Weather

Staff are mindful of hot, wet and stormy days and will adjust program, venues and events accordingly.

Use Sun Sense

Sunscreen should be brought daily and applied regularly. We encourage you to show your child how to apply sunscreen. Hats should also be worn every day.

Camp Swims

Many of our camps include a recreational swim as part of the programming. All of the town pools are supervised by fully qualified lifeguards. Swim testing will be conducted each week. Campers aged 6 and 7 will participate in Swim to Survive structured swim sessions. Pack a bathing suit and towel on these days.

What to Wear

Be prepared for your summer camp adventure! Dress for the weather and for the fun you'll be part of. For instance, if you'll be swimming or visiting the splash pad, don't forget your swimsuit, towel and water shoes...if you're going to be outside and it looks like a cloudy drizzly day, remember to pack your rain gear. Dress for a mess! Old clothes are the best. Please label everything.

Shoe Smarts

Closed-toe shoes are a must. Sandals and Croc-style shoes are not suitable for our outdoor or indoor adventures!



What to Bring

Pack a "litterless" lunch, snack and drink daily. We suggest a reusable water bottle (no glass please) so you can fuel up and have the energy to go, go, go! **Absolutely no peanut or nut products please.** Additional items may be required for camp-specific activities: i.e. bathing suit and towel for swim days, hockey equipment and skates for hockey camps, etc.

Lost and Found

Leave something behind? Please note that lost and found items cannot be confirmed over the phone. You must go to the facility in person. Items will be held for up to two weeks.

When to Play, When to Stay Away

When children show signs of illness, keep them home. This greatly reduces the spread of illness at camp. Ask your camp leader about the timeframe that a child must be symptom-free before coming to camp. A child may be sent home if coughing, sneezing, or has a temperature or a runny nose.

Medication at Camp

If participants require prescription medication during a program, parents/guardians must complete a medical consent form. Medication must be stored in its original container with only a one day dosage in it and given to camp staff each morning.

EpiPens and Inhalers

Any child bringing an EpiPen or inhaler to camp must bring it in a separate fanny pack/case to be worn at all times. A medical consent form must be completed.

Code of Conduct

We expect that all campers be courteous and respectful to all participants and staff; use non-offensive language at all times; support and appreciate each other; solve problems in a fair and peaceful manner; include others in their activities; and play without bullying or teasing others. The Behaviour Management process is a tool used by leadership staff to ensure the Code of Conduct is being followed by all participants registered in the program. The intent of progressive discipline is to develop the participant's understanding that appropriate social behaviour ensures each individual and the group as a whole will have a safe and enjoyable experience. Persistent behaviour issues are discussed between the staff and their immediate supervisor prior to determining the consequence.

Registration and Payment
