The schooling that children receive at FLM teaches them life skills that give them an indispensable advantage when they enter elementary school.

#### FLM FACULTY:

The director of Fun to Learn Montessori School, Ms. Shahla Ambreen, is an enthusiastic educator trained in both Montessori and Early Childhood Education. She is a Sheridan College graduate, and serves as a director on the Sheridan Alumni Association.

The staff at Fun to Learn is highly qualified - trained in both Montessori as well as Early Childhood Education. The Fun to Learn Montessori staff provides a calm, nurturing and caring environment in which children are free to grow and learn. Their years of experience and dedication help students flourish and reach their full potential.

#### PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Fun to Learn Montessori School practices principles developed by Dr. Maria Montessori for helping children to reach their full potential.

Children from 18 months to 36 months and 36 months to 6 yrs are grouped together to provide a family like setting where learning occurs naturally. The younger children learn from the older children. Older children share what they have learned while reinforcing their learning.

Our classes are conducted in sunny cheerful rooms. Each class has self-correcting Montessori materials that are designed to capture the child's attention and are addressed to a particular aspect of learning.

#### CURRICULUM:

According to Dr. Montessori's research, the absorbent mind of the child is at its peak between 3 to 6 years of age. Children of this age are natural learners and learning happens without effort. They are keenly attuned to everything that stimulates their senses (shapes, sounds, smells, textures, tastes) and do much of their learning by touching and manipulating the objects around them.

Our Casa room (3 - 6 years) is designed to allow the children to move, touch, manipulate and explore, giving them the freedom to choose their own activities with guidance from their teacher. Our environment encourages the children to work independently using their own initiative, building self-discipline, concentration and respect for others.

The Casa room is a "living room" for our children with child size furniture and materials scaled to fit the child's physical dimensions. The classroom is divided into the following areas:

- Practical life
- Sensorial
- Mathematics
- Language
- Geography
- Science and Cultural
- Library
- French
- Music

Physical education is also an integral part of our curriculum. French and Music are taught by specialists in the Casa program.

The Toddler classroom (18 - 36 months) offers very young children a unique year of self development, in a tender atmosphere of special understanding, respect and support. They are unique in the sense that they provide a very specific structure which fulfills the social, physical, emotional and psychological needs of each child. Toddlers are given opportunities to work in the development of language skills, art, music (taught by a specialist), sensorial and practical life. The emphasis is most on the practical life activities as they help very young children in the following areas: control of movement, grace and courtesy, care for themselves and for the environment. These are simple activities and can be accomplished by each child.

FLM is currently a member of the CCMA (Canadian Council of Montessori Administrators), a Member of ADCO (Association of Daycare Operators of Ontario), as well as RTBP (Raising the Bar in Peel). Our faculty and staff are also members of many non-profit early childhood education organizations.
