About AWL

Autism In Mind Children's Charity (AIM) have been providing specialized professional services and programs for children with autism regardless of their family's financial situation since 2014. AIM recognized the need to continue to grow with their children. On September 13, 2021 AIM Without Limits Private School has opened its doors to expand our non-profit services to provide full-time Ontario elementary curriculum based education option. We are now able to provide a tailored but equal education for children with autism without barrier.

The uniqueness about this school is that it is in a low ratio setting of 1:4, teaching Ontario curriculum in an ABA setting while combining the services of our multidisciplinary team of Ontario Certified Teachers equivalent, Behaviour Therapist, Speech Language Pathologist and Occupational Therapist. There are mindfulness breaks throughout the day to support children's emotional regulation and increase positive thinking. As part of the regular school program, we also include life skills training and vocational training to grow their skill to become independent.

Private Elementary School for children with autism

Ontario Curriculum with Multidisciplinary Team

Evidence-based education and treatment programs tailored to each student according to individual assessment. Each classroom will have a maximum of 10 students with weekly group Occupational therapy and Speech Therapy in the classroom.

Skill Building Focus

Daily program includes vocational training, life skills (tasks around the house) and social skills that will help children build a strong foundation to enhance their ability to participate in the community.

Best Buddy Program

Designed to provide a safe inclusion with friends who are ready to build a special friendship. This will include weekend outings and planned activities with peers in a community setting.
