ABOUT The ESL Experience at Rothesay Netherwood School

Rothesay Netherwood School (RNS) is proud to offer an extraordinary English as a Second Language (ESL) Summer Experience. This three-week program is designed for motivated students aged 12 to 18 years, who wish to enroll in an English speaking school or study English as an academic subject in their own country. The ESL Summer Experience focuses on reading, writing and oral comprehension. Classes take place on the picturesque 200-acre RNS campus located in Rothesay, New Brunswick providing a truly Canadian learning environment and experience. RNS has a long history of leadership among independent schools – a tradition of excellence and innovation since 1877.

During the course of this program, students will receive 25 hours per week of English language instruction from RNS's dedicated and professional teaching staff. Students are placed in an appropriate learning level and the classes are kept small, with a teacher to student ratio of 1:15. Our small class sizes allow for individual learning and the opportunity for leadership, development and personal growth through creative problem solving, team building and peer support.

The ESL Summer Experience at RNS also provides recreational activities, sightseeing tours and social and cultural events. These opportunities allow students to learn more about the Canadian culture and travel within
