A FEW THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND AS YOU MAKE YOUR CAMP SELECTIONS:

Camp Drop-Off & Pick-Up

Camps start at 8am (look at the attached schedule for specific time and duration of your camp). It is very important that campers are picked up on time. There is a late fee policy.

Drop campers off as early as 7am for \$30 per week. They must be registered for a camp starting at 8am.

Lunch

At our all-day camps, you have the option to purchase a lunch for a low daily price, or pack your own.

We do not provide lunchtime for half-day camps, so please make sure your child eats before camp.

Snacks

We provide snacks, juice and water throughout the day.

Attire

Kids should wear comfortable clothing and active shoes for activities such as swimming, rock climbing and games. If your club has rock climbing, skirts and dresses should be work with shorts underneath.

Swimming

Most camps have swimming, so pack a swimsuit and sunscreen (towels provided). Team members cannot apply sunscreen, so apply in advance and make sure they know how to reapply. If your child absolutely requires assistance to remain safe in the sun, you may sign a waiver and send them with spray sunscreen that does not need to be rubbed into the skin.

Registration

Please be thorough and fill out every field. If a line is not applicable, write N/A. Drop the form at the Activity Center. Space is limited and camps fill up quickly.

Ratios:

- Junior Camp - 1:6 ratio onsite and offsite
 - Junior campers (4-5 years old) – Born in 2013 and 2014. Must be 4 by the time camp week starts.
 - Swimming on Tuesday and Thursday
- Senior Camp – 1:10 onsite and 1:7 offsite
 - Senior Campers (Ages 6-12 years old) – Born in 2012 until 2006
- Swimming Ratios:
 - Swimmer: Children who pass the swim test by being able to swim the 25 meter lap lane unassisted will be in a
 - Children who do not pass or don’t want to take the swim test will be in a 1:3 ratio and will wear a life jacket

Drop in Fees:

- If you wish to sign up for camp the day of and there is space available there will be an additional payment of \$10 per day and \$25 per week.

CAMP POLICIES

General Camp Policies

1. Wear athletic shoes and dress comfortably for activity and weather.
2. Bring a lunch and water bottle. Lunches available for purchase.
3. Label all personal belongings.
4. To enroll, a registration form with payment is required to hold your spot.
5. Additional paperwork may be required for each participant prior to the first day. (Ex: Immunization records, etc.)
6. Field trips are subject to change.

Summer Camp Instructions

1. Find your camp.
2. Complete a registration form with full payment or deposit and submit to the Activity Center.
3. Complete the following paperwork prior to the start of your camp:
 - _____ Participation Agreement
 - _____ Climbing Waiver, if your child's camp includes rock climbing
 - _____ Disciplinary Acknowledgment Form
 - _____ Field Trip Agreement (initialed)

Campers will not be allowed to participate until all forms are completed.

Cancellation Policy

Refund Policy. All cancellation requests must be made in writing to the Activity Center. A \$50 non-refundable deposit will be required for all camps. The \$50 non-refundable deposit is included in the full week payment amount.

• **Payment Plan Refund Policy.** If a cancellation request is received more than 14 days before the first day of camp, I will receive a refund for the amount paid for each week of camp less the \$50 non-refundable deposit. If a cancellation request is received by Life Time less than 14 days prior to the first day of camp, I will be responsible for all camp payments/fees. I understand that failure to make a payment on any due date (whether in person or rejected EFT draft) will cancel my participant's registration.

• **Paid-In-Full Refund Policy.** If a cancellation request is received 30 days or more before the first day of camp, I will receive a full refund of all camp fees paid including the \$50 deposit. If a cancellation request is received 14 to 29 days prior to the first day of camp, I will receive a refund for the amount paid for each week of camp less the \$50 non-refundable deposit. If a cancellation request is received by Life Time less than 14 days prior to the first day of camp, I will forfeit all fees for camp services.

• **T-Shirts.** If the camp has a T-Shirt fee, it must be paid with the deposit and is non-refundable

Suggestions to pack for field trip days:

- Please let us know of any allergies and provide your child's epi-pen.
