- If applying for Indigenous peoples Scholarship, please provide status card, or photocopy of a community membership card, or official letter from a community member sponsor.
- Links to any digital media work, creation or portfolio (optional) that will help the committee decide on scholarship awarding to talented applicants.

Application Deadline: June 15th, 2022 Scholarship recipients will be announced on June 20th, 2022

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

One scholarship can only be applied to one currently offered DMA UBC Tech Summer Camp 2022 courses fee, excluding any hardware and software cost required for the specific course. No cash value. Camp course is subject to availability. Scholarship recipients are not guaranteed a spot in a course due to capacity limitations. Only valid for in-person UBC location Summer Camp and not for any virtual learning courses.

The scholarship program is administered by Halfmoon Education, DMA Greater Vancouver Exclusive Licensee, and sponsored by Halfmoon Foundation, a BC registered non-profit society, sister organization to Halfmoon Education. All scholarship awards are assessed and determined by a confidential Halfmoon Education, Canada scholarship committee.
