A TED Talk is a short presentation that focuses on **T**echnology, **E**ntertainment, and/or **D**esign. In this half-day weekly program, students will learn advanced research strategies, speak off the cuff for 2-3 minutes at a time, deliver timely evaluations and feedback, and work on active listening skills to outperform others in debates. They develop the use of purposeful gestures and vocal variety to emphasize important ideas. **Final Project for each week** is to deliver a 10-minute TED Talk in front of an audience based on the weekly theme.

- A: Yes, you can register for one day, half a week, or the full week. However, only full-week and daily drop-in registration is available online. Contact us if you need partial-week registration.
- Can my child stay in one station more than once a day if he/she prefers?
- STEM station is available once per student per day. Other stations can be repeated if there are spots.

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Registration & Cancellation Policy

Registration Process

Our online registration platform is Jumbula.com. You can register directly on focus-learning.jumbula.com. Or, your can visit our official website https://focuslearning.ca and go to our Summer Camp page or to the Registration page.

While on the registration page:

- 1. If you signed up for our 2022-2023 Winter/Spring programs, enter the email that you used for registration and click Forget password to activate your account. Contact Focus Learning if you don't remember your registration email.
- 2. Otherwise, Sign up for a new account.



Cancellation Policy

- Registration is completed only after full payment has been received or processed.
- 80% of the camp fee will be refunded on cancellations received 10 or more business days prior to the start of the camp session.
- 50% of the camp fee will be refunded on cancellations received less than 10 business days prior to the start of the camp session. Refunds will only be honored on full camp payments.
- There will be no refunds issued on or after the first day of camp. Cancellation due to unexpected emergencies is subject to a minimum of \$20 per week per person administration fee.
- Prorated refunds are not available for days absent. Campers can attend other camp programs as a makeup if there are spots.
- Transfers may be made up to two weeks prior to the start of a session provided there is available space in the desired program.
- Cancellation and transfer notice must be submitted in writing.
- Focus Learning reserves the right to cancel a camp with insufficient number of campers and will offer a full refund as a result. At least 2 weeks of notice will be provided.



Camp Q & A's

Q: What are the qualifications of camp instructors?

All of our program instructors are OCT certified or industrial experts with extensive teaching experience and have A: vulnerable sector background check.

Q: The pricing on your online registration website is for half-day weekly camps. How can I get the full-day weekly camp pricing?

Upon checking out, use the code FULLDAY for both the half-day camps in the same week. Only when the two half-day A: camps are in the same week will the FULLDAY coupon be acknowledged and accepted by Focus. Incorrect use of this code will cause an outstanding balance of \$20 for each of the half-day camps that has been applied to.

Q: Should my child bring lunches and snacks to camp?

Campers should bring one nut-free snack per AM or PM camp. They should bring their own lunches if not ordering A: through Focus Learning.

Q: Do you offer lunch plans?

Yes. You can order lunches through Focus Learning for Tim Hortons or a hot lunch provide by a certified school lunch A: provider. Please check our Summer Camp website for menu and pricing.

Q: Do you offer sibling discount? How about the referral discount?

Yes, we offer \$10 OFF for the second camper and all additional in the same family. When you refer a new camper, both A: you and the new camper receive a one-time \$20 referral discount. Contact us to redeem the discount.

May I transfer my child to other Focus Learning camps after registration? Q:

A: Yes. We will do our best to make the transfer as long as there are spots available. Each transfer is subject to a \$10 administration fee.

What forms of payment do you accept? Q:

Due to the volume of registration, only ONLINE CREDIT CARD payment via our online registration platform A: will be accepted.

Q: Will my child get a Focus Learning camp T-shirt?

A: Every camper will get an orange Focus Learning camp T-shirt based on the sizes you filled out upon registration. The first T-shirt is FREE of charge. Additional T-shirts are \$15 per piece.

Q: Can I register in person or through Focus Learning admin staff?

A: We are online-first for summer camp registration and payment. Any registrations made manually by Focus Learning Admin will be subject to a convenience fee of \$10 per person per registration. At the same time, the parent/guardian has to send us a signed copy of our Disclaimer, Off-Property Consent, and Cancellation Policy.

Q: What if I am running late to pick up my child?

Our PM extended care runs until 5:30 and the camp site will be closed at 6 PM. If you are running late, make sure to A: contact us at your earliest convenience, either by phone or email. Late pickups after 6 pm will be subject to a surcharge of \$20 per half hour.




