More than 20,458 Maple Leaf grade 12 graduates have studied at over 809 universities in more than 30 countries and regions.



SCHOOL LOCATION - METRO VANCOUVER

Maple Leaf World School - KPU is situated within Kwantlen Polytechnic University's Richmond campus. The school is located in the heart of a diverse Vancouver-based suburb and is often ranked as one of the best locations in the world in which to live and study. Vancouver, a major city on Canada's west coast, is often referred to as Canada's gateway to the Pacific. It is among Canada's most ethnically diverse metropolitan areas, with a population of 2.5 million. It is well known as an urban centre surrounded by nature, making it a major tourism destination.

In addition to active film production studios, along with video game and tech companies, Vancouver is also a centre of higher education. It is home to 11 public post-secondary institutions including universities, technical institutions and colleges, and dozens of private specialty institutions. Vancouver's weather is mild year-round with clean fresh air. Summer temperatures average in the mid-20s°C with low humidity, while winter months, though rainy, seldom go below 0°C. Vancouver rarely sees snow, yet the nearby ski hills offer great winter sports opportunities.

Thirty minutes from downtown Vancouver will bring you to Grouse Mountain Resort to the north, or Cypress Mountain Resort to the northwest. Both of these locations are world-class ski resorts that were some of the 2010 Winter Olympics events were held. Vancouver is the perfect location for enjoying downtown life with nature on your doorstep.

ABOUT KWANTLEN POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY


Kwantlen Polytechnic University (KPU) is a Canadian polytechnic university that integrates teaching, research and innovations in preparing students for fulfilling careers. Established in 1981, KPU offers degrees, diplomas and certificates in more than 120 programs. The Richmond campus is located in the heart of a vibrant and very ethnically diverse community on a 10-acre urban site. The campus features modern classrooms, state-of-the-art graphic design computer labs, interior design work studios, and fully equipped science labs. The campus also includes a cafeteria, student lounge areas, indoor and outdoor courtyard spaces, a library and a learning centre.

FACILITIES

Through its partnership with Kwantlen Polytechnic University, the school provides an optimal environment for learning and teaching. Our facilities share cafeteria, library, and science lab space with the university to offer a globally recognized curriculum that inspires students to outperform. The school's learning environment includes small classes and welcoming recreational spaces. Students receive access to an Olympic-designed sports facility which can be used both during and outside of school hours. The school enjoys a quiet location within the university where students are safe and supervised.

HOUSING

MLWS-KPU has partnered with First Choice International Placement, a company with over 20 years of experience providing international students with safe and supported homestay accommodations. Students live in a caring, family environment, developing relationships outside of the classroom. All homestay families are English speaking with homes located within 30 minutes of the school. Two students are paired with one homestay family, and each student has their own separate furnished room. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided by the host family.



Having a warm homestay family is very helpful for any international student. When I first came to Canada and was not familiar with the surroundings, my homestay family helped me quickly integrate into life here. After more than two years living side by side, my homestay family treat me like their own daughter.

UNIVERSITY ADVANCED START

Maple Leaf Educational Systems has partnered with recognized public universities in Canada to offer quality high school programs located right on university campuses. APPLICATION & SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE

At Maple Leaf World Schools, **trained school advisors guide our students step-by-step through the university admission, selection and scholarship application process**.

For students who have chosen to study university courses as part of their Maple Leaf experience, official university transcripts are provided to document the courses taken. These university courses can be applied to qualifying universities and count toward their studies – thereby saving time and money for students and their families.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS AND TUTORIALS



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
