Lynn-Rose IB World School is subject to a strict accreditation process monitored by the IB Organization, ensuring that Lynn-Rose provides a high-quality education.


Lynn-Rose experienced and gifted OCT teachers are required to continually participate in many IB professional development training workshops to promote their awareness of current educational practices and new thinking.



IB programmes challenge students aged 3 to 19 to excel in their studies, and encourages both personal and academic achievement. IB programmes are specifically designed for three separate age groups: (PYP) Primary Years Programme, (MYP) Middle Years Programme and (DP) Diploma Programme. STEAM refers to the integration of Science, Technology, Engineering, Art + Design and Mathematics. These subjects encourage and drive innovation. STEAM is an approach to teaching and learning that truly enhances our IB program of inquiry. It is also a way that we can continue to strengthen and develop our links throughout all three IB programs we offer that are presented in the IB model. Referred to as "approaches to teaching" and "approaches to learning".

STEAM has four main principles: to teach inquiry based lesson, integrate curriculum between various disciplines, emphasize project-based learning where students see the connections to workplaces, and show continuous improvement through the learning process. The integration of STEAM (as an approach to teaching and learning) will further equip our students with the skills needed to embrace challenge, make a positive contribution to society and to not only creatively solve problems, but to pose them as well.







The Foundation

Primary Years Programme - PYP (Pre-K - Grade 6)



The Lynn-Rose Heights Primary Years Programme (PYP) is the foundation your child needs in order to maximize their potential growth moving forward. With a skilled team of active and versatile faculty, your child will gain the academic base necessary to succeed

in an IB environment, the self-confidence required to advocate for themselves within that environment and the self-awareness to understand how they learn best within the classroom. The Lynn-Rose Heights PYP is founded on a philosophy that recognizes a child's natural curiosity, creativity and ability to reflect. The Lynn-Rose Heights PYP generates a stimulating, challenging learning environment to nurture those assets and foster a lifelong love of learning in every child.

Within the Lynn-Rose Heights PYP, students learn about significant concepts through units of inquiry. There are six transdisciplinary themes that guide the Units of Inquiry throughout the year.

Units of Inquiry interweave subject areas such as mathematics, language arts, science and social studies. This approach encourages students to make their own connections between what they learn in core subject areas and how it relates to the world around them.


The Lynn-Rose Heights Primary Years Program includes STEAM + IB which engages our students in hands on learning and inventing, building on engineering and design.

Lynn-Rose Académie Language B Our signature Extended French Programme

Pre-Kindergarten - Grade 3 (Stage 1): The Lynn-Rose Heights French Language B Programme is offered to students JK-3, our students study French daily to increase the fluency of the French language. Our students practice French with their classmates and work collaboratively on projects and presentations. This programme runs alongside our regular daily programming.

As the students progress through the programme, they will expand on their counting, classification and writing skills. The students will expand on French oral and written communication skills. This foundation will set the stage for entry into our advanced French Reach Ahead Programme offered in grade 4-8. The French Reach Ahead programme offers our students a secondary school French credit in grade 8.

Middle Years Programme - MYP (Grades 7 - 10)



The Lynn-Rose College Middle Years Programme (MYP) is a five year programme that blends the comprehensive and structural foundation of the PYP with the academic distinction of the Diploma Programme (DP). Our staff of experienced facilitators assist each

individual student to manufacture the necessary level of independence, academic discipline and desire to achieve their goals. Upon completion of the programme, your child will be in an optimum position when selecting their post-secondary school, and eventual career choices.

In the Lynn-Rose College MYP classroom, students are at the centre of learning. They are drawing connections between all subject areas and how those subjects link to the world around them. Lynn-Rose College MYP learning blends global points of view to encourage a better understanding of other cultures that support a common ground in real life experiences.

Lynn-Rose College MYP curriculum framework comprises eight subject groups, providing a broad and balanced education. Lynn-Rose College students take the core courses of language and literature, individuals and societies, mathematics, sciences, physical education, language acquisition, arts, and design.

The Lynn-Rose College MYP (grades 7 to 10) is designed to give our students options of advanced study in the grades 11 and 12 pre-university entry years.

The Lynn-Rose College MYP will give students the opportunity to continue their education with the (IB) DP programme in grades 11 & 12 with required pre-requisites.

The Diploma Programme (DP) Grades 11 - 12



DP is regulated by the International Baccalaureate Organization. Lynn-Rose College (DP) students graduating with the IB diploma are able to study at universities around the world, often with advanced credit. Students are well prepared with research skills,

self confidence and have the ability to manage their time effectively. The DP is internationally recognized as representing one of the highest standards in university preparatory education. The Advanced Placement Programme (AP) Grades 11- 12
