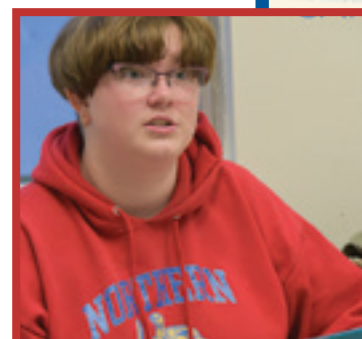
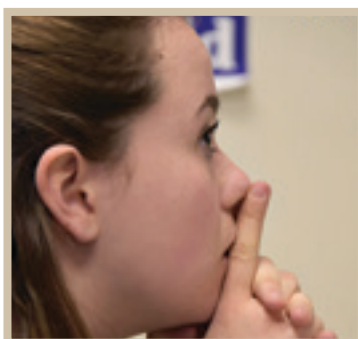
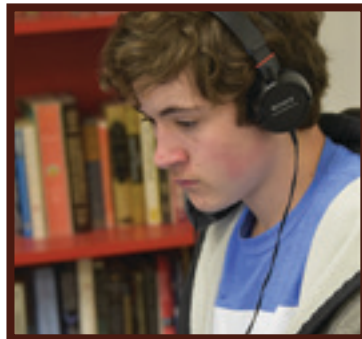

WHAT MAKES TSS *UNIQUE*?

1. *Individualized Instruction*

Standardized Tests:

As part of OSSD requirements, we offer EQAO (Education Quality and Accountability Office) tests, as needed, in Grades 9 and 10; we also offer the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course. Additionally, due to interest among many TSS students, we also provide support for writing:

- AP (Advanced Placement) Program
- Euclid and CEMC Math Contests
- IELTS (For International Students)



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4. Students

In addition to curriculum, students engage in physical, hands-on and character-building activities.

Students enrol at a joint recreational and athletic centre. In addition, building teamwork, communication, and leadership skills are emphasized through fun recreational activities.

We also incorporate visits to universities, car plants, and factories to inspire student development and draw connections to the real world.

Students are offered a wide range of extra-curricular activities to choose from. Some include: photography, music, yoga and soccer.



5. Teachers

Our faculty is comprised of teachers who are knowledgeable, experienced, and passionate about the Art of Teaching. Our instructors are certified by the Ontario College of Teachers or are graduates from Masters and PhD programs.
